# Application and Health Record

Application and health record MUST be filled out COMPLETELY and signed by all campers. The state of Colorado requires every camper to give a copy of their physical simply stating that each camper is healthy enough to play in the mountains. The physical is still good if it is dated AFTER June 11, 2016. You may attach it to the application form or take the health record form to your doctor to sign.

Please list all medications and treatments that your camper will need while at camp. A Doctor must sign off on all medicine or medication listed on the form. Campers cannot bring any medicine that is not listed on the form.

#### WHAT TO BRING:

Money for four meals while traveling, Bible (Let me know if you don't own one), pen or pencil, notepad, toothbrush, touthpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, towels, washcloths, sleeping bag or bed roll (It gets cold at night), jacket, pillow, extra spending money for concessions and shopping.
