

Greetings from Bassenheim, Germany. It is with great joy that we write this letter to you. We pray this letter finds you doing well. God is good all the time and He has rained down blessings upon us during this winter time.



Elisabeth Lucinda Taylor "Lucy" was born on the 29<sup>th</sup> of December 2019. From the minute we entered the hospital until Lucy was born took exactly nine minutes! It was a true blessing to have almost our whole family from El Paso, Texas with us for the birth of our 4<sup>th</sup> child. Nicole's mother, sister and only niece came a few days after my parents arrived just before Christmas. Lucy is healthy and strong and we thank the Lord for giving us such a precious beautiful blessing. Nicole is healing well and she is doing good. Lucy's siblings enjoy holding her and entertaining her between feedings and nap time. Thank you for praying for us.

We have been quite busy here in Bassenheim, as we endeavor to reach as many people around us with the gospel of Jesus Christ. We have already seen a few salvations during an evangelistic event and a visitor that has gotten saved at the beginning of the year! God continues to bring visitors into the church on a weekly basis. It is a true blessing to partner with the Hastings and McCollum family. God has been blessing the work here and without the help of the Hastings and McCollums it would be very difficult to say the least.

On the 18<sup>th</sup> of February we had our winter VBS (*Kindergottesdienst*) at church. We had about 65 people in attendance, over 40 of which were children. We had numerous guests and we had an opportunity to present a clear gospel message. Our next VBS will be in October, we are looking forward to seeing what God will do in the hearts of our children.

In the last few weeks, we have added to our membership. A single lady that is a teacher in a Christian school and a family of four recently joined. We have over ten candidates for baptism and I am striving to see them all baptized during the summer. In November we paid off our building. Shortly after paying off our mortgage, our church voted on taking out a loan to renovate our 110+ year old building. God has given us many talented men that have built their own homes and other buildings. Renovations have begun and the men have been very faithful in construction. The concern voiced by many in the church is "why should we renovate when we are asking the Lord to give us a new building." To hear the same men preaching on Sunday shows the spiritual growth at our church!
